

Dear Parent/Carer,

Welcome Back P4-P7



Firstly I wish to welcome all our wonderful children in P4-7 and their families back to St Ninian's on Monday 15th March. Once again we have had a very long time apart and we cannot wait to see you all. We know that it may not be as easy a transition to settle in after such a long break but we have done this before and I assure you that the St Ninian's team are fully committed and ready to help support your children to ease back into school life as smoothly as possible. As always the wellbeing of the children is our central focus.

As all pupils return to school we will implement some updated and revised routines which have been established to fully ensure the safety of all children and staff.

As before each class will reform in their class bubble. Lateral Flow Testing kits are now available to all school staff who wish to take part in testing. Any member of staff or pupil who is identified as being a close contact will now be asked to book a covid test as well as isolating for 10 days. If a member of your household is awaiting a covid test result/shows symptoms do not send your child to school. Staff will continue to social distance from pupils and other staff members (2 metres). Staff will continue to wear face coverings. All members of the school community (pupils and staff) will continue to follow good hand hygiene rules and wash hands at set and regular intervals.

Drop Off Pick Up

Please see below for relevant drop off and pick up times.

We would remind parents to arrive at the school as close to these times as possible and leave the area after drop off and pick up. Parents/carers are not permitted on school grounds. Face coverings should be worn around the



school perimeter and especially if socially distancing is difficult. Smoking is also not permitted. We would also ask that consideration to others and residents around the school is given when parking.

Gates open and pupils can be dropped off from 8.45am (or from 8am for breakfast club).





Taking into account Scottish Government advice we will once again stagger the start/finish times to prevent any gathering and overcrowding in the drop off areas of the school as follows:
