Chris Duke was in last Friday to speak to children about his book and we have purchased copies for each class to read to children too.

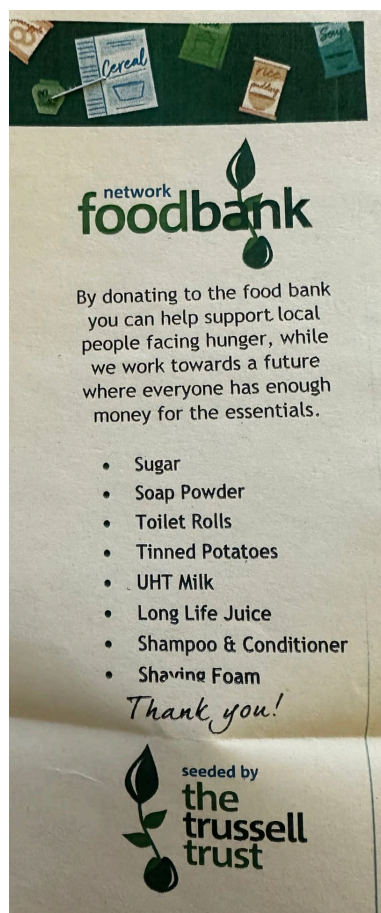
Lucy's Blue Day by Chris Duke
