#### **Covid Update**

As cases continue to rise throughout Glasgow we would remind you of the guidance with regards to self-isolation;



You should self isolate if:

- You have symptoms that may be caused by Covid 19
- You had a positive test result, even it you aren't experiencing symptoms
- Someone you live with has symptoms but has not yet been tested or received their test result
- You're told to self-isolate by NHS Test and Trace as a close contact of someone who has tested positive, until you are able to take a test.

We would also remind parents/carers not to gather around the school perimeter but to drop your child off then leave and when picking up arrive as close to the pick up time as possible. Please also wear an appropriate face covering unless you are exempt.
