We have contacted the Police who have provided an incident number and will inspect the classroom and any available CCTV. I would urge you to be vigilant and if possible contact the police if you see anyone in the classroom outwith school hours. If you could make our community aware so that collectively, we can ensure our school is kept safe and in order for our children, thank you.
